



## Suggestions for Touring the Stewards of Change Institute Interoperability Mural Gallery

You could spend hours viewing the content of this gallery (okay with us!) or just a few minutes walking through for a visual blast – or anything in-between. Whatever you have time for, here are a few suggestions to enhance your experience:

1. Pick up a Gallery Program Guide to read descriptions of the sections and murals. Please drop your guide at the exit for use by the next visitor.

2. Listen to a brief audio tour by scanning this QR code:

*Point your camera at the code or use the scanner app on your phone, if you have one.*



3. Inside, read the description that accompanies each mural.

4. Note there's a “guiding question” in each room. Please think about one or more of them and add your replies to the “idea board” in the final section.

5. Talk with the “docents” who will be strolling around inside the gallery. They are all subject matter experts in various areas related to the murals.

6. Watch the short videos inside to learn more about us and our work.
