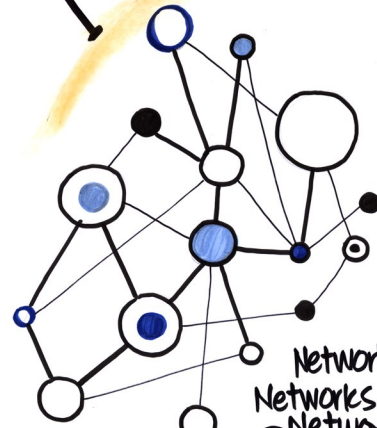

What's the BIG PICTURE?



TWO-GENERATION APPROACH
Initiative to provide INTERVENTION to children and their parents.

BRIDGE DIFFERENT COMMUNITIES with technologies, standards, ISES, frameworks.

"CHILD WELFARE" occurs at multiple junctions - How do we capture and exchange data across touchpoints?
"The INFORMATION is NOT all in one place!"

COLLABORATIVE STRUCTURES

How do we LINK child welfare, judicial oversight, data collection, data analysis and evaluation?

FUNDING and GRANTS for BUILDING INFRASTRUCTURES and SYSTEMS designed for INFORMATION/DATA EXCHANGE.

- Connect the silos.
- Planning upfront is more cost-effective in the long run.

Look at INITIATIVES like the DRUG MONITORING INITIATIVE in New Jersey

- Real-time INTELLIGENCE
- Data EXCHANGE
- Model of COORDINATION
